

# AUUC – Reentry Guidelines for Renters During COVID

The following guidelines apply to individuals and groups that contract with AUUC to use church space during the COVID-19 pandemic. AUUC will make every effort to support and ensure the success of planned rental events during this difficult period. However, AUUC reserves the right to cancel any upcoming rental event or activity, possibly on short notice, if Fairfax County's COVID numbers as calculated on Covid Act Now are in the orange (high risk) zone or worse, or if AUUC determines that the County's COVID matrix is trending upward in a manner that will likely put us in the orange or red zone at the time of a planned rental event.

In addition to the requirements in the AUUC Rental Policy and Procedures document (see link in Facility Rental section on AUUC home page), until further notice renters must:

1. Not use AUUC to store, prepare, or consume food or drink. Case by case exceptions will be considered.
2. Upon completion of their activity, wipe down with paper towels and germicidal cleaner all chairs, tables, hard surfaces, equipment, and other church materials used during their activity. Throw used paper towels in trash receptacles.
3. In the same manner, sanitize AUUC bathrooms used during the rental activity.
4. Before leaving the building, check in with the on-site AUUC Building and Grounds representative, who will monitor completion of above tasks. (Note: This requirement does not apply to long term contractual renters who have been granted independent access to the building to conduct their activities.)

Further, AUUC strongly recommends that renters:

1. Require full vaccination for all participants/attendees of the rental activity.
2. Require masking for all participants/attendees of the rental activity while they are in the building.
3. Ensure that appropriate social distancing is maintained between individuals and/ or household groups during activities taking place in the building.

AUUC is not responsible for any COVID infections which might result from renters' use of AUUC facilities. In this regard all renters use AUUC facilities at their own risk and with the knowledge that they should take all necessary and prudent steps to help ensure the health/safety of their participants.
